## Featured Paper Pumpkin Kit:

- One Great Year, December 2015

## Additional supplies used:

- 137414, Bow Builder Punch
- 135346, Project Life Corner Punch
- 119850, 1-3/4" Circle Punch
- 115316, Rich Razzleberry Cardstock
- 131203, Soft Sky Cardstock
- 101731, Craft Whisper White Ink
- Sentiment is from the July Paper Pumpkin Kit: Thanks A Latte

## Instructions:

1. Card Base: Soft Sky Cardstock measuring 11" x 4-1/4". Score in the center at 5-1/2" and fold. Use the Corner Punch to punch the two bottom corners.
2. Layer #2: Rich Razzleberry Cardstock 5-1/4" x 4". Use the Corner Punch to punch the two bottom corners. Glue to card base.
3. Layer #3: Designer Paper from the kit measuring 2" x 4". Use the Corner Punch to punch the two bottom corners. Glue to the bottom of the Rich Razzleberry layer.
4. Stamp the tiny flower in white ink above the designer paper layer repeatedly across.
5. Use the 1-3/4" Circle Punch to add a hole above the stamped flowers through both layers of cardstock about 3/4" from the right edge. Glue the flower from the kit in the center of the hole using Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Stamp the sentiment from the July Paper Pumpkin Thanks A Latte kit, using white ink.
7. Cut a piece of designer paper measuring 1/2" x 4" and glue about 1/4" from the top of the Rich Razzleberry layer. Cut the pieces for the bow using the designer paper and the Bow Builder Punch. Assemble the bow and glue to the top where you glued the designer paper strip.
