

Pocketful of Cheer Sneak Peek

Featured Paper Pumpkin Kit:

- Pocketful Of Cheer, March 2016

Additional supplies used:

- Bermuda Bay Cardstock, Item #131197

Instructions:

1. Card Base: Bermuda Bay Cardstock measuring 11" x 4-1/4". Score in the center at 5-1/2" and fold.
2. Layer #2: Cut the long flap off of the designer paper envelope and glue to the very bottom of the card base. Trim to fit.
3. Layer #3: Use one of the Bermuda Bay diagonal striped strips and cut to 4-1/4" long. Glue over the top of the designer paper.
4. Inked Flowers: Stamp the flower repeatedly above the striped strip horizontally leaving enough room for the Baker's Twine.
5. Baker's Twine: Tie a piece of Baker's Twine around the whole card front and tie into a bow. Position between the stamped flowers and the striped strip.
6. Circles: Peel off 3 of the self-adhesive circles and glue about 1-1/4" from the top and evenly spaced horizontally. Stamp the flower image on the two outside circles.
7. Sentiment: Using the sentiment, ink the word "HOORAY" only by inking on the very edge of the ink pad and stamp in the center of the middle circle.
