

Julie's Stamping Spot Julie Davison

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Let's Celebrate Turtle Treat


Supplies:

Very Thankful stamp set
Family Phrases stamp set
Jet Black Staz-On Ink
Certainly Celery, Old Olive, & Real Red Markers
9-3/4" x 2-3/4" Certainly Celery, scored at 2", 2-3/8", 5-7/8", and 6-1/4"
2-1/8" x 2-1/2" Old Olive cardstock
1-1/2" x 7-1/4" Real Red cardstock, scored at 2", 2-3/8", 5-1/4", & 5-5/8"
Whisper White scrap cardstock
So Tweet Chipboard
Scallop Edge Punch
1-3/4" Circle Punch
Word Window Punch



Instructions:

1. Punch the Word Window punch in the middle of the 2" end of the Certainly Celery cardstock. Use Sticky Strip to adhere the end of that square to the inside of the cardstock strip, forming a pocket for the candy.





- 2. Use the Real Red marker to color the heart and set aside.
- 3. Carefully ink the turtle with Staz-On ink and stamp on Whisper White scrap cardstock. Color in with Certainly Celery, Old Olive, and Real Red markers. Punch out using the 1-3/4" Circle Punch
- 4. Stamp the greeting at the bottom of the Old Olive cardstock. Adhere the circle with the turtle above it. Adhere the chipboard heart using SNAIL adhesive.
- 5. Use the Scallop Edge Punch to decorate the edge of the Real Red cardstock. Put a piece of Sticky Strip on one end. Wrap it around the Certainly Celery treat and make any necessary adjustments to the fit before peeling backing off Sticky Strip and adhere the band together.
- 6. Use Sticky Strip or Stampin' Dimensionals on the top (ONLY) of the Turtle embellishment and adhere to the front of the treat holder. The red band will slide on and off the treat to hold it closed and slides under the turtle embellishment. These two pieces are NOT attached.



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
