1. Cut and score along edges.
2. Add image or journaling to area $D$ of waterfall strip.
3. If desired, punch hole in right edge of area $D$ and attach ribbon.
4. Stamp $2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares $(A, B, C)$ as desired.
5. Fold strip in half so that areas $A, B$, and $C$ lay on top of area D.
6. Adhere square $C$ to back of area $C$ of waterfall strip.
7. Place adhesive on back of area $B$ and attach square $B$. Note: Square B is substantially larger than area B. Only adhere the left side.
8. Place adhesive on back of area $A$ and attach square $A$. Note: Square A is substantially larger than area A. Only adhere the left side.
9. Lay waterfall strip on standard size card front (4-1/4" x $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ). Layer $1^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strip on top of area D. Area C should lay on top of 1 " $\times 4-1 / 4$ " strip. Attach $1^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 4$ " card stock strip to card with eyelets. Note: Area D should be able to slide freely behind 1 " $\times 4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ card stock strip.
10. Adhere area $C$ to $1 " \times 4-1 / 4$ " card stock strip.
11. Gently pull area $D$ to the right. As it slides under the 1 " $\times 4-1 / 4$ " card stock strip, back of area A should flip and lay flat against card front. If desired, add journaling to area A .
12. Continue gently pulling area $D$ to the right. Back of area $B$ should flip and lay flat against card front. If desired, add journaling to area $B$.
