

Box Card with Drawer

It's a box. And a card! This reminds me of those LifeSavers Storybooks they sell around Christmas. You can put lifesavers or wrapped candy in your box, or use it to package a small ornament or other gift.





Supplies:


Fun & Fast Notes stamp set, In My Thoughts stamp set, Sweet Stars Jumbo Wheel, Certainly Celery cardstock & marker, Rose Red cardstock, Whisper White cardstock, So Saffron marker, Rose Red marker, Ticket Corner Punch, 1 ¼" Circle Punch, Circle Rhinestone Brads, 1/16" Hole Punch, Sticky Strip, SNAIL Adhesive

Cardstock Dimensions:

- * 3" x 12" Certainly Celery cardstock
- * 47/8" x 47/8" Certainly Celery cardstock
- * 2" x 2" Whisper White cardstock
- * 2 ¼" x 2 ¼" Rose Red cardstock
- * scrap of Rose Red cardstock

Directions:


1. Score Certainly Celery cardstock at 3", 4", 7", 8", and 11". Decorate with wheel and stamps as shown in the picture below.



2. Fold up the box so the sticky strip edge adheres to the inside of the cardstock, forming a box with open ends.



- 3. For the drawer, score the 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" piece of Certainly Celery cardstock at 1" from each edge. On two opposite ends, use scissors to cut on the scored line up to the perpendicular scored line.
- 4. Use sticky strip on the corners and fold them in to the sides to make the drawer.
