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Retro Serigraph Technique



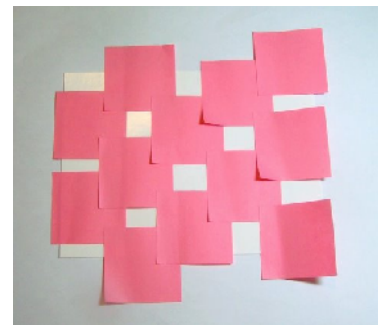
Supplies:

- Glossy White Cardstock
- Classic Ink Pads, three shades of the same or similar color (Cajun Craze, More Mustard, and So Saffron)
- Versamark Ink Pad
- Stamps (Falling Leaves)
- Small Sticky Notes
- Rubber Brayer

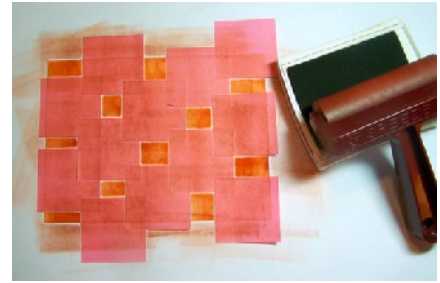


Directions:

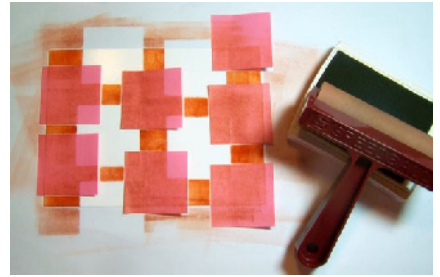
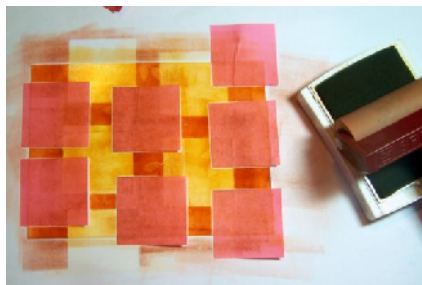
1. Stamp image in Versamark ink all over Glossy White cardstock. Note: This technique is easier to do on a larger piece of cardstock. You can cut it down later to use on your project.
2. Cover the cardstock with small sticky notes, leaving small areas open with the cardstock showing.



3. Starting with the darkest of the three colors, use the Brayer to apply ink over the cardstock until the ink is spread uniformly as desired.



4. Remove half of the sticky notes to reveal the white cardstock underneath. Use the Brayer with the medium ink color to apply ink to the open areas of the cardstock.



5. Remove the rest of the sticky notes. Use the Brayer to spread the lightest ink color over the remaining open areas of the cardstock.



6. The Versamark ink should have resisted the ink and the stamped images should show through in a very light color. Stamp additional images in the medium and dark colors to create a collage.
