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Crimped Envelope Pouch

Supplies:

1 Medium Whisper White Envelope
4 ¼" x 2" Real Red Cardstock
I {heart} Hearts stamp set
Delightful Dozen stamp set
Real Red ink pad
Pretty in Pink ink pad & marker
Wisteria Wonder ink pad
Jet Black Staz-On ink pad
Scallop Edge Punch
Paper Cutter
Dazzling Details Glitter Glue
Paper Crimper



Directions:

1. Lick and seal the envelope closed. Use a Paper Cutter to cut 1 ½" off one end of the sealed envelope.
2. Stamp hearts in collage style on the bottom (larger) half of the envelope. Make sure the opening is at the **top** so your images aren't upside down.
3. Use a Paper Crimper to crimp the bottom (larger) half of the envelope. Send it through the Crimper so that the opening is on the side. The finished crimp should have vertical lines on the envelope pouch. (The crimp reduces the overall width of the envelope pouch so that the top can easily slide over it.)
4. On the smaller envelope half, stamp the greeting in Jet Black Staz-On ink. Make sure the opening is on the **bottom** when you stamp so that your greeting isn't upside down. Color the heart with the Pretty in Pink marker. Add Dazzling Details glitter and allow to dry.
5. Use the Scallop Edge Punch to punch one long side of the 4 ¼" x 2" piece of Real Red cardstock. Put adhesive on one side of the cardstock. With the adhesive side up, slide it into the smaller half of the envelope and adhere the cardstock to the **inside front side** of the envelope. (By attaching it to the inside front side, the scallop edge will hang over the front of the pouch when it's closed.)
6. Put candy, a note, or gift card inside the pouch and slide the top over close the pouch.
