Double Punched Blossom Card

Supplies:

Mixed Bunch Stamp Set
4 ¼" x 4 ¼" Concord Crush Cardstock
4" x 12" Whisper White Cardstock
3" x 3" Melon Mambo Cardstock
Concord Crush Large Oval Punch
Whisper White Cardstock Scrap
(2) 2" x 4" Cheerful Treat Designer Paper
Concord Crush Marker
Melon Mambo Marker & Ink Pad
Modern Label Punch
Blossom Punch
1" Circle Punch
Simply Scored Tool
Rhinestone Jewel Accents
Stampin' Dimensionals



Directions:

1. Use the Simply Scored Tool to score the Whisper White cardstock at 2", 4", 8", and 10".
2. Hold the ends of the Whisper White cardstock together (without folding or creasing the middle) and punch through both layers together. Use the Blossom Punch and put it all the way in, centering the punch on the score line. Note: It will be easier to punch if you lay the punch flat on the table. You can still use it upside down to see where you are punch, but place the top of the punch flat on the table.
3. Use SNAIL Adhesive or Glue Stick to adhere designer paper on each end of the Whisper White cardstock. The Designer Paper should come right up against the score line.



4. Use the Blossom Punch to line up and punch through the designer paper.
5. Stamp the flower from Mixed Bunch in Melon Mambo ink on Melon Mambo cardstock. Punch out with the Blossom Punch.
6. Stamp the flower center in Concord Crush ink on Whisper White cardstock. Punch out with the 1" Circle Punch.
7. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the circle to the center of the flower. Add a Rhinestone in the center of the flower.
8. Fold the card on all of the score lines in a Z type fold so that the designer paper flaps are on top. Hold the front of the card down and use the Blossom Punched Window to line up the Melon Mambo flower. Adhere the flower to the inside of the card using Stampin' Dimensionals. Open the card. (The first time you open the card, it may get caught up on the flower. That's okay, just gently maneuver around it.)
9. Put SNAIL Adhesive on the back of the center of the Whisper White cardstock and adhere it to the Concord Crush cardstock.
10. Use markers to color the greeting stamp and stamp on Whisper White cardstock. Punch out with the Modern Label Punch. Layer on to a Large Oval Punch of Concord Crush cardstock. Put adhesive on half of the back and adhere it to one flap of the card front. (Note: Make sure to only glue down one half of the greeting or the card will be glued shut!)
11. If desired, stamp a coordinating saying inside the card, under the flower.



Change the colors and use a different pattern from the Cheerful Treat Designer Paper for a whole new look!
