Floral District Card Box

Measurements:

8 1/2" x 11" Baja Breeze cardstock

6" x 4 1/4" Floral District DSP for lid

2" x 2 1/2" Floral District DSP for tag

6" x 1 3/4" Floral District DSP & scraps for punching

1/2" x 3" Whisper White cardstock

1/2" x 6" Rich Razzleberry cardstock

Rich Razzleberry Large Oval Punch

30" Organza Ribbon


Mini Silver Brad

This box will fit five embellished cards plus envelopes!



Tag Instructions:

1. Use the Simply Scored Diagonal Plate to score the Floral District Designer Paper for the tag at 1 1/2". Flip the tag over and score the other top corner at 1 1/2". Cut off the corners of the tag.





2. Punch out seven 1 1/4" Scallop Circles using the scraps of Floral District Designer Paper. Stack them together and pierce through the middle with the Paper Piercing Tool. Attach the circles together with a brad.




3. To create the flower, “scrunch” each scallop circle up toward the center. Be careful not to tear it. [You can use water or rubbing alcohol in the Stampin’ Spritzer to soften the paper, but just be careful not to use too much or the paper will tear.]
4. Fold the Rich Razzleberry Large Oval punch in half and use SNAIL adhesive to adhere it over the top of the tag. Use a hole punch to punch a hole through the center of the oval.
5. Stamp the greeting on the Whisper White cardstock. Cut a banner tip on one end. Adhere the greeting to the tag using SNAIL adhesive.
6. Adhere the Designer Paper flower with Stampin’ Dimensionals near one end of the greeting.

Box Instructions:

1. Use the Simply Scored Tool to score Baja Breeze cardstock at 1 1/4” and 7 1/4”. Turn 90 degrees and score at 4-7/8” and 6-1/8”.



2. Cut from the outer edge of the center scores to the perpendicular score line on both sides.
3. Apply Sticky Strip to the small center flap and the long flaps on one end.
4. Assemble box by adhering the sides together.



5. Use the Simply Scored Tool to score the Floral District Designer Paper for the lid at 2 1/4” and 3 1/2”.
6. Apply Sticky Strip on the back of the small flap and adhere to the back of the box.



7. Tie the Organza Ribbon around the box, adding the tag to the ribbon before tying a bow.
