

5 Ways to Use Tag Topper Punches



The <u>Tag Topper Punches</u> are so easy to use! Simply cut a piece of cardstock or paper to 2" in width, slide it in the punch, and push down to create a decorative edge! It even punches the hole perfectly in the center of the top of the tag!

I am sure there are many more, but here are the five ways that I used the Tag Topper Punches:

- 2. **Punch both ends** of the cardstock for a unique tag.
- 3. Make a **bookmark**. Make a long tag and layer it on another long tag.
- 4. **Create a Box**. Cut cardstock to $2'' \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ and score at $2 \frac{1}{2}$ and $3 \frac{1}{2}$. Punch both ends. The side pieces are $1 \frac{1}{2}$ x $1 \frac{1}{2}$, scored at $\frac{1}{2}$ from the opposite sides.
