



5 Ways to Use Tag Topper Punches



The [Tag Topper Punches](#) are so easy to use! Simply cut a piece of cardstock or paper to 2" in width, slide it in the punch, and push down to create a decorative edge! It even punches the hole perfectly in the center of the top of the tag!

I am sure there are many more, but here are the five ways that I used the [Tag Topper Punches](#) :

1. Create a **traditional tag** for a card, scrapbook page, or gift. For more Tag Topper Punch project ideas, go to <http://tinyurl.com/mbottoy>

2. **Punch both ends** of the cardstock for a unique tag.

3. Make a **bookmark**. Make a long tag and layer it on another long tag.

4. **Create a Box**. Cut cardstock to 2" x 6 1/2" and score at 2 3/4" and 3 3/4". Punch both ends. The side pieces are 1 1/2" x 1 1/2", scored at 1/4" from the opposite sides.
