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## Pull Out "Fun Fold" Card

### Supplies:

Remembering Your Birthday stamp set  
Birthday Cake stamp  
Raspberry Ripple ink pad & marker  
Summer Starfruit marker  
Island Indigo marker  
4" x 9 3/4" Whisper White cardstock  
4 1/4" x 5 1/2" Island Indigo cardstock  
3/4" x 5 1/4" Birthday Basics Designer Paper  
Pennant Builder Punch

### Instructions:

1. With 4" side at the top of the Stampin' Trimmer, line up the Whisper White cardstock at 1 1/2" and CUT from 3" down to 7 1/2".
2. Turn the cardstock 90 degrees. Line up the cardstock at 3" and score down to the cut line at 2 1/2".
3. Move the cardstock over to 5 1/4" and score all the way down.
4. Move the cardstock over to 7 1/2" and score from 2 1/2" down to the end.
5. Fold on all score lines. From left to right, the first score line will be folded "mountain" style and the second score line will be folded "valley" style.
6. For the banner, use the Pennant Builder Punch to cut the banner pieces from the scraps provided at each table. Adhere the pennants to the card using Mini Glue Dots.
7. Tie two tiny bows from the Baker's Twine and adhere to the corners of the banner using Mini Glue Dots of Tombow Multi Adhesive. (For a less bulky bow, pull the twine apart and use 3-4 strands.)
8. Stamp the greetings with Raspberry Ripple ink. Make sure the inside greeting is stamped closer to the score line so it is not visible when the card is closed.
9. Use the Raspberry Ripple, Summer Starfruit, and Island Indigo markers to color the Birthday Cake stamp and stamp on the right side of the card.
10. Fold the card. Apply adhesive to the very back (not the part that will pull out) and adhere to the card backing (4 1/4" x 5 1/2" Island Indigo cardstock).
