## 7 Ways to Use the Silicone Craft Sheet

- 1. <u>Heat Resistant</u>: Use it for protecting your work surface when heat embossing elements.
- 2. Hot Glue Mat: Clean up is a breeze when you use your hot glue gun over the Silicone Craft Sheet!

  Add a large dot of hot glue in the middle of the mat and add petals or other pieces and then pull up your finished element with ease.



3. <u>Emboss with your Dies or Masks</u>: Layer the silicone mat with masks or dies to create an embossed look. Here's how to create your "sandwich", from Bottom to Top: Platform, Cutting Pad, Silicone Mat, Cardstock, Mask, Cutting Pad.



- 4. Reflection Technique: Stamp an image on cardstock. Stamp again on the Silicone Craft Sheet and the turn it over and press down to transfer the inked image to a piece of cardstock.
- 5. **Sponging**: The smooth surface will make it easy to sponge the edges of your

cardstock. When you're done, simply rinse the ink off with water.

- 6. <u>Resists Adhesive</u>: Protect your work surface from sticky adhesive by applying adhesive to your projects over the silicone mat. It will catch any "run off" adhesive and won't get, or stay, sticky!
- 7. <u>Watercolor Palette</u>: Add ink refill or ink pad direct to silicone mat and add water to create a washable and reusable watercolor palette.
