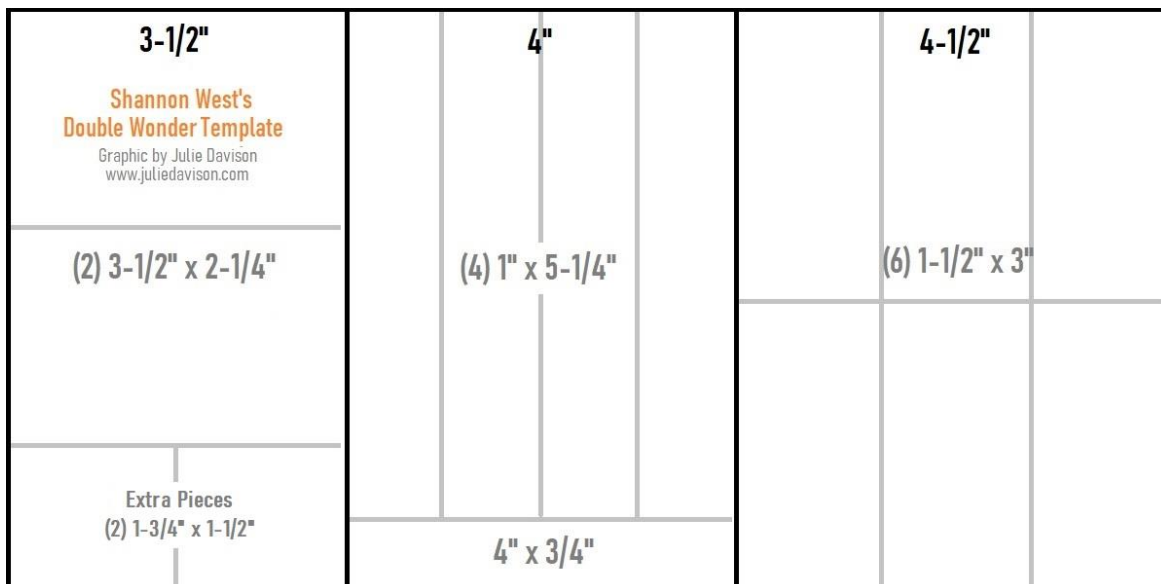


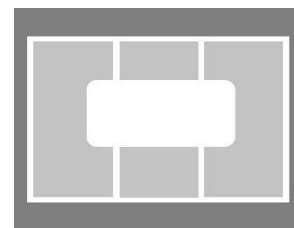
# Double Wonder Cards

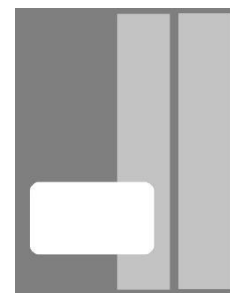
## Layout #1 (4 Cards)

- Cut 4-1/2" off the end of the Designer Paper and cut into 1-1/2" x 3" pieces.
- Mix and Match the pieces on to a 3-1/4" x 5" piece of Whisper White cardstock.
- Add a ribbon across the center.
- Stamp and punch a greeting and add to the center with Stampin' Dimensionals.



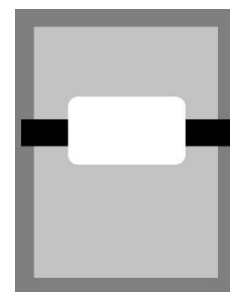
## Layout #2 (4 Cards)

- Cut 4" off the end of the Designer Paper. Cut 3/4" off one end (set aside for layout #3) and cut the remaining piece into 1" strips.
- Score one end of the card base at 1-1/4". Fold the cardstock back toward the front. (Optional: Glue flap down.)
- Adhere one piece of designer paper to the flap. Adhere a second piece of designer paper to the inside edge of the card.
- Stamp and punch a greeting and add to the left side with Stampin' Dimensionals.



## Layout #3 (2 Cards)

- Cut the remaining 3-1/2" x 6" piece into two 3-1/2" x 2-1/4" pieces.
- Center the designer paper at the top and bottom with even space around the sides and top/bottom.
- Add the 4" x 3/4" strip of designer paper across the middle.
- Stamp and punch a greeting and add to the center with Stampin' Dimensionals.



## Layout #4 (Bonus Card)

- Cut the 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" piece in half (at 1-3/4").
- Arrange the four extra pieces in the center of a card front.
- Stamp and punch a greeting and add it to the center with Stampin' Dimensionals.
